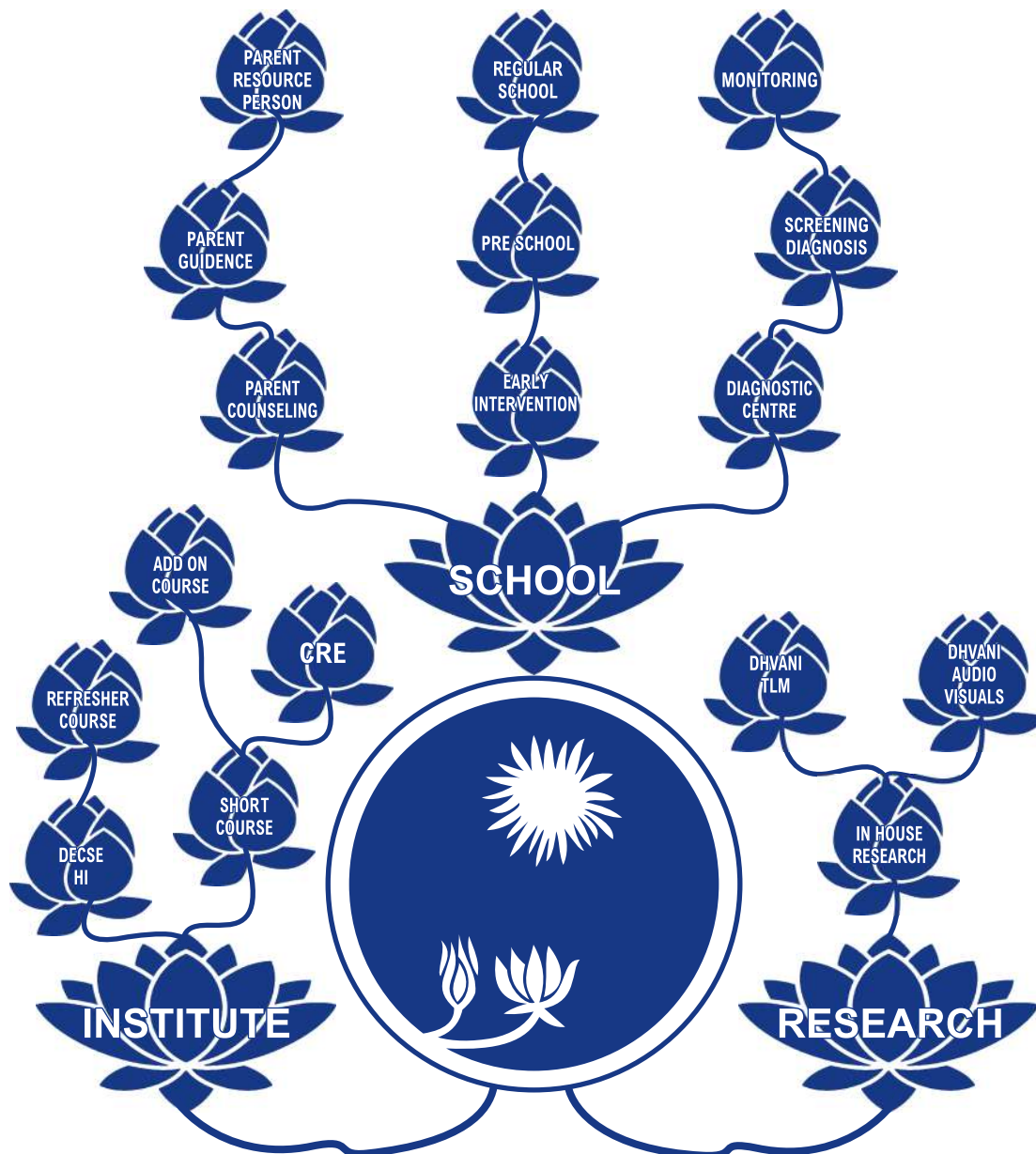

It gives me a great pleasure to present the 55th Annual Report during the 55th Annual Day of the school.

Balavidyalaya The school for young deaf children is an early intervention center where we admit infants and young children with hearing loss when they are below 3 years old. Our youngest child till date has been all of 52 days old.

Children are helped to develop language and speech using our DHVANI methodology. At the age of 3 they are helped to develop academic skills of reading, writing and numeracy. They complete our programme when they are 6 years old and join 1st standard in any regular school of the parents' choice.

All services in the school are offered fully free. The school is managed by Balavidyalaya Trust which is a not for profit organisation.

54th Annual Day celebrations

The 54th Annual day of the school was celebrated on the 30th of March 2024. Ms G.L.Sowmya, our alumna presided over the function as our Annual Day Chief Guest.

ACADEMIC YEAR

Due to the Lok Sabha Elections we had to close earlier than usual. The school closed for the academic year 2023-24 for the children on the 12th of April 2024 and for the staff on the 18th of April 2024

We reopened for the academic year 2024-25 on the 10th of June 2024.

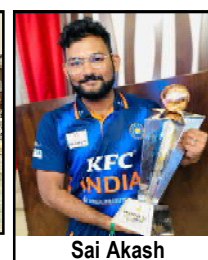

Nithila Prasanna in class tenth wins quiz competitions in a Inter school Science Expo and painting competitions.

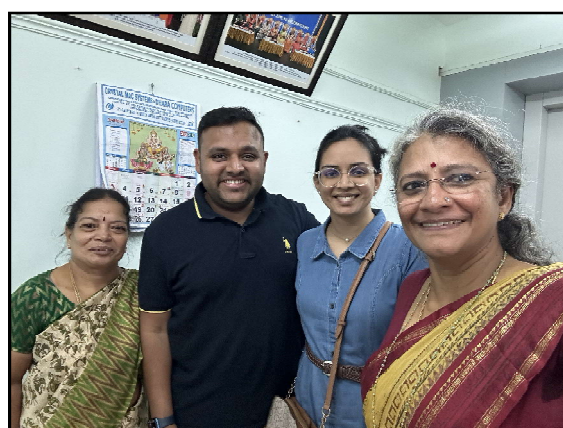

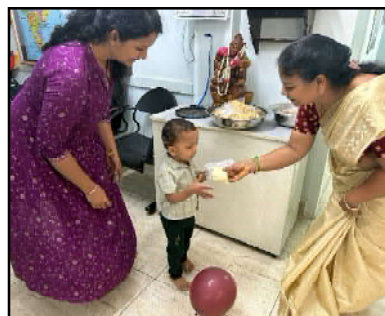

This constant support from all our donors is unmeasurable.

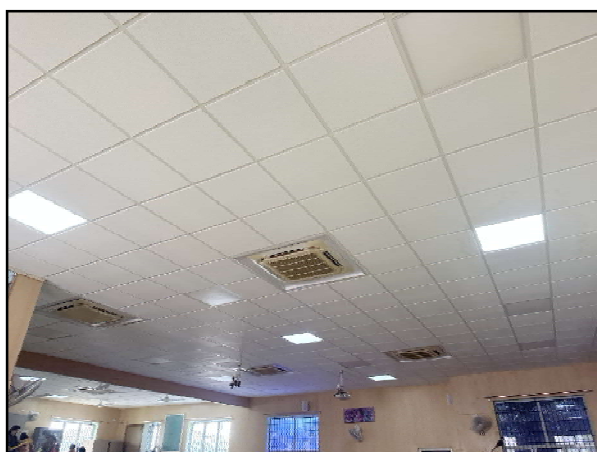

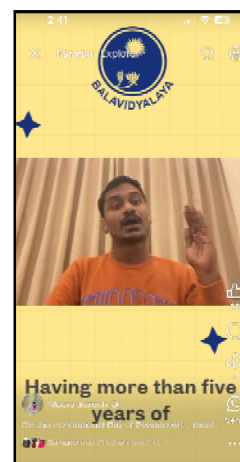

The staff made Pongal. Kolams were drawn and a decorated pot with Pongal was kept. The Pongal was then distributed to everyone.

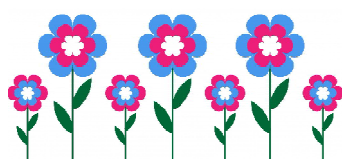
viii) Independence Day

SPEECH BY MR SRIDHARAN GRAND FATHER OF CHANVI A CHILD LEAVING FOR THE MAINSTREAM IN JUNE 2025

Good evening everyone.

I would like to thank Balavidyalaya for the opportunity they have given me to talk before you today.

My name is Sridharan. I am from Madurai. Here in Balavidyalaya I am known as Chanvi's Thatha.

I would like to share my profile briefly. I got married to my sister's daughter Usha way back in 1984. She was working in LIC an Office of the Central Government. In 1991 we were blessed with a daughter Abi Prashanti. When my daughter was 2 years old we realised she has a hearing loss. We enrolled her in YMCA Deaf preschool a special school in Madurai. She then joined the 1st standard in Cabrohall HSS Madurai and developed little speech skills. She completed her school education and went on to join B.E in Computer science in Kalasalingam University Srivilliputhur. I decided that she need not work so she did not look for any job. When it was time to get her married my daughter was very clear she only wanted to marry a deaf boy. We found a boy T.V.Sabari Vengatesh who has a hearing loss. He studied in TVS Lakshmi Higher Secondary School and went on to Kalasalingam for a B.E in Computer science. He talks as well as signs. He was working in Standard Chartered Bank in Bangalore. They got married in 2017. The couple led a happy life.

In 2019 Chanvi was born. On the first day itself I felt Chanvi was not hearing as I had dropped a tumbler and she did not respond with any reflex. I shared this suspicion with my wife immediately. We were both so worried. As part of the Universal screening test the hospital checked Chanvi the day after she was born. They confirmed she has a hearing loss. We were devastated and decided not to tell my daughter and son in law immediately. After 3 months I shared this information with them. They were so shocked. My daughter started crying and kept saying that she wanted to commit suicide. I promised her that I would help. I consoled her and said I would somehow find some place that could help her to talk and she should stop thinking of taking such drastic action. I started looking for help on the internet and

came across Balavidyalaya's Website. I immediately contacted Balavidyalaya -by then Chanvi was 3 months old. I told Balavidyalaya about my issue. They told me to bring Chanvi to Balavidyalaya and said by the age of 6 years she would be ready to join the 1st standard of any school.

I was running a small Electronic Spare Parts Business. I could not close my business and come to Chennai. I did not know what to do. Finally, when Chanvi was 9 months old I managed to make a trip to Balavidyalaya and got her enrolled on 28th of February 2020. I had not yet decided how I would bring Chanvi. I gathered all information from Balavidyalaya and went back to Madurai. The plan was to think what to do. In March, Corona the pandemic hit the world and we were on a lockdown. Balavidyalaya started online classes. I attended a few classes online. I could not understand what the teachers expected of me. I tried everything they said, but I could see neither of us, the teacher or me were satisfied. We were both getting frustrated.

Finally on the 15th of October 2021 Balavidyalaya announced that they would start offline classes. I wound up my business and brought Chanvi to Balavidyalaya on the said date. Chanvi was at that time 2 years and five months old. Balavidyalaya was very particular that the caregiver must be oral and constantly talk to Chanvi. So I decided to be the caregiver. We, my daughter, Chanvi and I took a house in Karapakkam OMR. My wife stayed back in Madurai and my son in law in Bangalore. I brought Chanvi to Balavidyalaya everyday by motorcycle. Chanvi was given a one-hour class to begin with as per their policy. I found when I was taking Chanvi back home in the motorcycle she used to sleep off which worried me. So I decided to shift to Adyar. My Son in law visited us whenever he could. In 2022 my wife retired from her services in LIC and joined us in Adyar. In 2023 my son got a transfer and relocated to Chennai.

In Madurai, I was the boss with three assistants working for me. Here in Balavidyalaya I had to listen to the teachers and my ego was finding it difficult to deal with this. At times I wondered what I was doing in Balavidyalaya listening to them. The teachers in Balavidyalaya were very patient with me and kept explaining how to work with Chanvi. While waiting for Chanvi to finish her one-hour class I spoke to some of the parents

of the senior children in Balavidyalaya. They explained how the children are progressing and kept guiding me saying listen to what the teachers are saying. They convinced me Balavidyalaya was helping us. Gradually I began to understand what Balavidyalaya expected of me and their syllabus. I changed my behaviour towards Balavidyalaya and started to work according to what was expected of me. By that time Chanvi was three years old and started reading her lessons and I had to read home lessons with her. Balavidyalaya was conducting spoken English fluency classes for the parents. I attended some of them. At home Chanvi was not cooperating with me. She was taking very long to finish her lessons. The teachers kept guiding and coaxing me. They insisted I had to continue working with Chanvi.

Chanvi slowly began to listen and cooperate. She started to constantly talk to us and to the teachers in Balavidyalaya. Surprisingly when it came to communicating with her parents, she was signing to them. I think she has realised they sign more to each other.

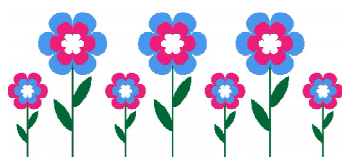
Chanvi kept progressing from level to level. Balavidyalaya has told me I can enrol Chanvi into the 1st standard in any mainstream school. I have got admission into Bain School in Kilpauk and Acharya School in Adyar. I am yet to decide which school to enrol her in.

The last few years with Chanvi and Balavidyalaya has been a humble learning experience for me. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Balavidyalaya for all the help rendered to Chanvi and me. I thank God for guiding me to Balavidyalaya.

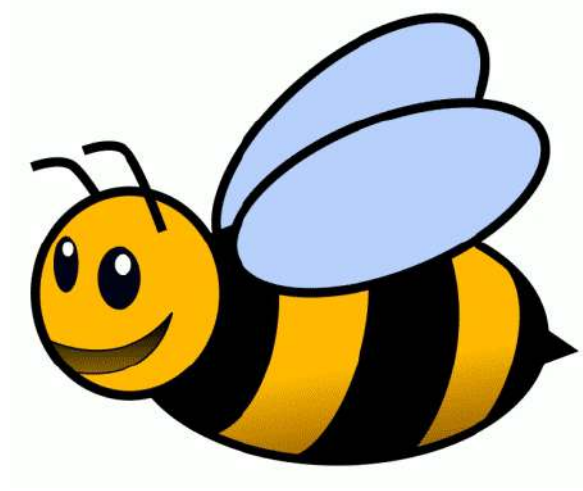
